HOW2 PREPARE YOUR MATCH FISHING GROUNDBAIT

Put your groundbait in a large mixing bucket. If you're not sure how much you need, start off with a small amount to avoid wastage. If you are combining two or more groundbaits together, do this now.

Spice up your mix by adding in some liquid attraction! Mix your chosen liquid in the water first for even distribution into the groundbait.

Give the groundbait a good mix by hand. Once it is well mixed, leave it for around 15 minutes to have reached your chosen consistency. Pour in a bit at a time; remember you can add water in, but you cannot take it out. A good base is to mix 500ml of water with 900g of groundbait.

Use this time to set up the rest of your swim.

allow all the water to be

absorbed.

The groundbait is ready to use. Whether you wrap it around a method or ball it in with added particles - you're sure to get great results!

Once it has settled, remove all lumps by pressing the groundbait through a riddle. This will help create a perfect, fluffy mix.

Tip use a damp towel to cover up the rest of your goundbait so it doesn't dry out in the sun. Simply add a dash of water to spruce it up if needed.
