We are welcoming you to share your catch results and send us your pictures for publication across our website and social media platforms - as well as the chance to receive a prize. Have your story and photo shared to other anglers around the world and join the Fin Crowd! There is no cost to take part, but you must fully read the rules on the following page of this form before you enter.

Any images and catches which we deem suitable may be posted across our social media channels; your name, photo and information about the catch will be shared. *Note: we will never share contact information and we assume full consent for your images to be shared on our platforms. You must read the full terms and conditions before entering.*

COMPETITION & PRIZES

There are three methods of entry that fall under the Fin Reports banner, they are the Carp Report, Match Report and Coarse Report. You can enter any/all reports each month, but you should only enter a photo of the relevant species of fish for each entry. There will be one chosen winner each month from all Match, Coarse and Carp entries. The winner will receive a **£25 voucher** to use online at www.spottedfin.com. The 'winner' will be selected solely by Spotted Fin Ltd - this is not to be considered a random choice.

RULES AND GUIDELINES

- To be in with the chance of winning a prize, you must use the entry forms on spottedfin.com, entries sent outside of this form may not be considered.
- You must be at least 16 years of age to enter and be eligible for a prize.
- Any persons included in the photo you submit must give you their permission for the photo to be shared. Any persons under the age of 16 should have permission from their parent/guardian for their photo to be shared.
- Any prize awarded will be given only to the entrant who completed the form, regardless of who may be included in the winning photo.
- Ensure you include as much detail as possible, particularly in the last field, where we ask you to describe the story of your catch.
- All entries should be caught using Spotted Fin products.
- Except for the 2 supporting images, all fields in the entry form are mandatory
- You must include at least one image with your entry. Send your best photo as the 'main image' and include 2 supporting images for best results.
- Your main photo should be in landscape format. Ensure the entire fish is in the image and you are clearly visible.
- Your photo should be sent as a JPG, with a maximum file size of 5mb.
- Ensure your photos are in full colour, and of a high quality.
- Although we may find it desirable that you are wearing Spotted Fin branded clothing, this will NOT influence the decision when choosing any prize winners.
- You must be the sole owner of the photos you include with your entry. We accept no liability for said images being redistributed unlawfully.
- By entering, you are granting permission to Spotted Fin to publish your photos and information at any time, via any of our online channels. We may publish your name and photo, but will never publish your contact information.
- Spotted Fin will select their favourite entries on a monthly basis. Each monthly period will start from the first day of the month and end on the last day of the month. If there are no entries in any month, the prize will not rollover.
- Spotted Fin will make every reasonable effort to contact prize winners via their email address and phone number to claim their prize. Any entrant which cannot be contacted within 14 days will forfeit their prize.
- There is no limit to how many entries each person can make, but do not enter the same catch twice.
- We will not accept entries of an inappropriate nature, that promote poor fish care or may cause offence.
- This is not a random competition. Spotted Fin alone will decide which, if any entrants receive prizes or have their images and stories shared.
- The competition is not open to any persons who are employed by or work on behalf of Spotted Fin Ltd.
- Spotted Fin reserves the right to deny prizes to any or all entrants without warning or explanation.
